Please note that any ad-hoc sessions during the term must be paid for via your child's Scopay account as we are unable to claim additional funding during the term.

All requests will be allocated subject to availability in accordance with our admissions policy, which can be found on the school website.

# NURSERY COLLECTION

We'd like to remind parents that children can only be collected by adults with permission to do so.

The nursery team will not release your child to anyone (whether they are known to the school and nursery or not) for whom we have not received your prior permission.

# SPRING 2024 INVOICES

Please remember that if you chose the option to pay in two instalments, the second and final payment is due by Friday 16th February 2024.

Please note that a £20 surcharge will be applied for late payments so please ensure timely payments are arranged to avoid unnecessary additional fees.

Tax Free Childcare payments can take up to 5 working days to clear so please ensure you arrange payment in plenty of time to reach us by the deadline dates provided above.

# DEN INSET DAY BOOKINGS

We are pleased to advise that we are offering childcare for all children from Nursery to Year 6 on our Inset Day on **Monday 4th March 2024**. If you require childcare on this day please complete the form below to book your child's

complete the form below to book your child's sessions. Please complete one form per child. Bookings will be taken on a first come first served basis. Sessions can be booked for a full day, school day or half day.

Booking deadline: Friday 16th February
Payment deadline: Wednesday 23rd February
\* Finish times are subject to demand.

Bookings must be paid for by above payment deadline to confirm your child's place. No refunds are given for cancellations received after the payment deadline.

Confirmation will be sent to you via email along with information on how to make payment. No refunds will be given for sessions cancelled after those payment deadline dates. We accept payment via your child's Scopay account as well as Childcare Vouchers and Tax Free Childcare.

#### Den Spring 2024 INSET day booking

Our hourly rate of £7.50 per hour applies to inset day bookings. We cannot claim funding for these sessions so these are payable via the usual channels.

# MEDICATION IN SCHOOL

If your child will require medication in nursery, including eye drops, creams and lotions, please ensure that you provide it to the nursery team at drop off and complete the **ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICINES FORM**. Medication must be in date and in the original packaging, clearly labelled with your child's name.

For the safety of your child and other children in nursery medication must not be left in your child's bag.

# TAX FREE CHILDCARE

Parents can receive up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare at both Hordle Explorers Nursery and The Den Breakfast and After School Club. For every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay in £2 to use to pay for nursery/Den fees so it is well worth applying if you are eligible.

Child under 12? You could get £2 for every £8 you spend on childcare. childcarechoices.gov.uk



Your eligibility depends on whether you are working, your income (and that of your partner), your child's age (the scheme is available up until age 11) and circumstances.

For further information on this scheme, to check your eligibility and set up an account please visit the **website**.

If eligible, you will be provided with a **unique Tax Free Childcare reference number**. This

must be provided to us before you make any

payments to either the school or nursery via this
account. Please email your unique reference
number to **hen@hordleprimary.co.uk** Please
entitle the email "TFC reference".

Please note that payments to us via the TFC scheme can take up to 5 working days (and usually longer for the first payment) and we require an email to confirm the date the payment was made and the total amount paid. This enables us to follow up on the payment with the Hampshire accounts team and allocate it accordingly.

## YELLOW WRISTBANDS

In an incident when a child has bumped their head, they will be issued with a yellow wristband and sent home with a letter.

This is so it is clear to a collecting adult that an incident has occurred and a child needs to be monitored for any signs of concussion.

May we please ask that yellow bands are not removed by grandparents and family friends collecting a child until the child is back home with their parents to avoid miscommunication.

### IMORTANT DEN CHANGE OF HOURS

Thank you to those parents who completed The Den opening hours consultation that was sent out in November, we had a very good response rate to this survey and it was extremely helpful to hear your views and understand how you use The Den for your child.

The findings of the consultation were shared with Governors at a meeting last week and after much deliberation it has been agreed that The Den closing time will move from 6pm to 5.30pm (Mondays-Thursdays, with the current finish time of 5pm to remain in place on Fridays). Whilst we appreciate that the earlier finish will impact upon a small number of our families who use the 6pm session more regularly, sadly we cannot continue to run until 6pm as it is no longer financially viable for us to do so. From your feedback, we are aware that offering a session time to 5.30pm will be helpful to some families and we hope that parents understand our reasons for making this decision.

This change will not come into effect until 15th April 2024 (Summer term) to provide families with sufficient time to make arrangements.
