IMORTANT DEN CHANGE OF HOURS

Thank you to those parents who completed The Den opening hours consultation that was sent out in November, we had a very good response rate to this survey and it was extremely helpful to hear your views and understand how you use The Den for your child.

The findings of the consultation were shared with Governors at a meeting last week and after much deliberation it has been agreed that The Den closing time will move from 6pm to 5.30pm (Mondays-Thursdays, with the current finish time of 5pm to remain in place on Fridays). Whilst we appreciate that the earlier finish will impact upon a small number of our families who use the 6pm session more regularly, sadly we cannot continue to run until 6pm as it is no longer financially viable for us to do so. From your feedback, we are aware that offering a session time to 5.30pm will be helpful to some families and we hope that parents understand our reasons for making this decision.

This change will not come into effect until 15th April 2024 (Summer term) to provide families with sufficient time to make arrangements.

IMPORTANT FUNDING INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

EYE funding enables nurseries to claim up to 38 weeks funding per year and Hordle Explorers Nursery opens 39 weeks per year. This means that there is a shortfall in funding over the course of the year which results in our funded children receiving an invoice.

The maximum number of hours and weeks we can claim per term does vary year on year and when your child exceeds these hours, parents will be charged for sessions at our standard hourly rate of $\pounds7.50$ per hour.

This academic year the shortfall has occurred in Spring and we have claimed funding for 11 weeks of a 12 week term. A further invoice may be incurred for some families in Summer term if your child has run out of claimable hours at this point (this depends upon your child's funding start date and the number of hours they attend).

Please plan ahead for this and note that nonattendance or a request for a reduction of hours will NOT be accepted in lieu of payment. Please note that families are not charged for Inset Days and Bank Holidays and therefore any invoices will take these days into account and will be reduced accordingly.
