



What does my child need for a day at Nursery?

Playing can get messy whether in the classroom or in our beautiful woodland garden and that is why we encourage children to come to nursery dressed appropriately for having lots of fun every day. We ask that children come dressed in clothes appropriate for the season and outdoor play and we provide a seasonal Parent Guide to clothing which can be found <u>HERE</u>. We request that families apply sun-cream to their child before arriving for their nursery session. Every day your child needs to arrive wearing:

Clothing Kit List

- Wellington boots for outdoor play
- Slipper socks for indoor play
- Named hat appropriate for the season
- Hordle school hoodie or jumper (optional)

A Rucksack

- Spare trousers and jumpers
- 2-3 pairs spare pants and socks
- Named waterproof trousers
- Named jacket or coat appropriate for the season
- Please include more spares if your child is potty or toilet training
- Pull ups, nappies and wipes if your child is potty or toilet training

Additional Items

- Packed lunch in a named, hard, washable lunch box (which should include an ice pack to keep food cool)
- Named and filled water bottle

We request that to prevent loss or damage, children are encouraged to leave toys at home where they can be kept safe. For safety reasons please do not send your child to nursery wearing jewellery, crocs or open-toed sandals.
