EYE FUNDING INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

EYE funding enables nurseries to claim up to 38 weeks funding per year and Hordle Explorers Nursery opens 39 weeks per year. This means that there is a shortfall in funding over the course of the year which results in our funded children receiving an invoice.

The maximum number of hours and weeks we can claim per term does vary year on year and when your child exceeds these hours, parents will be charged for sessions at our standard hourly rate of £7.50 per hour.

This academic year the main shortfall has occurred in Spring and we have claimed funding for 11 weeks of a 12 week term so many of our funded families have received an invoice. Thank you for those who have made prompt payment for these.

A further invoice may be incurred for some families in Summer term if your child has run out of claimable hours at this point (this depends upon your child's funding start date and the number of hours they attend).

Please plan ahead for this and note that non-attendance or a request for a reduction of hours will NOT be accepted in lieu of payment. Please note that families are not charged for Inset Days and Bank Holidays and therefore any invoices will take these days into account and will be reduced accordingly.

2 YEAR FUNDING UPDATE

As many of you will be aware, the Government announced at the last budget that there would be some significant changes coming to 15 and 30 hours childcare funding support for 2 year olds in England which will begin from April 2024 for working parents. For full details on this please consult the letter attached to this Nursery Note (originally sent on 13th November).

Whilst we still do not have information on the details of this, we would encourage all working parents of 2 year olds to register on the **<u>Childcare Choices government website</u>** which will provide you with advice on when the best time to apply for your child's funding will be. Please could we ask that you follow the advice on the recommended time to apply and diarise when to make your application.

Once you have registered on the site, you can subscribe to receive updates on the funding. The system will ask you to register with your email address and your local authority (please select Hampshire).

Please don't forget that the Tax Free Childcare scheme is also available to most families to support with the cost of childcare. For further information on how to apply please read the attached letter.



ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION

If you know that your child will require medication on any given day, please ensure that you provide it to the school office and ensure that the morning dose is given before 8am to enable us to administer again at 12 noon.

Please can we remind families that any medications, including prescription medications are administered at midday. Please consider this when administering medications before school starts to ensure that sufficient time between doses has been applied.

ROAD CLOSURE

Everton Road will be closed from Monday 15 January for approximately 12 weeks due to essential gas maintenance works. There will be no through vehicle access past the closure on Everton Road between 215 and Manor House for the duration of the work. A signed diversion route will be in place for road users.
