## Invoices - Summer Term 2025 Final Payment Reminder

A kind reminder that any remaining balances for Summer invoices are to be paid by the **deadline of Friday**23<sup>rd</sup> May.

Please note that a £20 surcharge will apply for late payments, so please ensure timely payments are arranged to avoid unnecessary additional fees.

Please see the email sent with your invoice for details on the various options available for making payment. Please note that if you are paying by Tax Free Childcare Scheme, we must receive your unique TFC code BEFORE you make a payment to us (these can be found on your TFC account, on your child's account). Please be aware that TFC payments can take up to 5 days to clear as available funds on your TFC account and a further 5 days to clear as a payment to Hordle Primary School. Therefore, please ensure these payments are made in advance to ensure the payment arrives with us by the deadline.

If you are paying by Childcare Vouchers please send an email to hen@hordleprimary.co.uk to advise that you have made a payment so that we can make the Hampshire Accounts team aware and your payment can be allocated to Hordle Explorers.

In line with our admissions policy, we will shortly be in the process of allocating sessions for Spring term 2026 and would like to know which sessions you require. Please complete the form below by **Friday 23rd May 2025**.



Please note that if you wish to continue with your Autumn term sessions, you only need to select this option on the form and then you can submit. If you wish to make changes please complete the rest of the form, indicating your preferences. We will do everything we can to accommodate your requests - if you are flexible on the sessions offered, please indicate this in the notes section provided at the bottom of the form.

We also offer HEN Breakfast Club and After School Club at The Den for all nursery children which for pre-booked sessions, we are able to claim funding for (dependent on eligibility).

Please indicate on the form if you require either club on a regular basis.

Please note, any ad-hoc sessions during the term must be paid for via your child's Scopay account as we are unable to claim additional funding during the term.

## Useful Reminders

#### Personal Items

As we head into Summer, we kindly ask that you check your child's spare clothes bag holds appropriate clothing. Children are currently still required to arrive to nursery dressed ready for the day e.g. waterproofs and suitable footwear.

Please ensure all personal items are clearly named.

Please can we remind families that personal items such as toys or lip balm, are not to be brought in to nursery.

#### Packed Lunches

#### Nut Free School

Please remember that we are a nut and sesame free nursery due to some severe allergies within school. This includes desserts such as Battenburg and Bakewell, hummus and many cereal bars - please check ingredients before adding to your child's packed lunch.

### Tupperware & Bottles

Please can we ask that all tupperware and bottles provided for children are plastic only, not glass.

Please ensure all personal items, including tupperware, bottles, coats, waterproofs and spare clothing are all clearly named.

A kind reminder to also ensure all fruit and/or small lunch box items are chopped appropriately for choking reasons.

#### Rate increase reminder

We wish to advise, from September 2025 the hourly rate for unfunded hours will increase from £7.50 to £8.00. This comes as the first hourly rate increase since September 2023 and has been agreed by Governors to support the continued running of our busy nursery setting, which has seen significant increases to staff and resourcing costs in the last two years. ### Booking ad-hoc sessions

Can we please remind parents that all additional sessions including Breakfast and After School Club bookings are to be made by either emailing hen@hordleprimary.co.uk or calling 01425 611657. Please **do not** book using your child's Scopay account (as you would with school-aged pupils).

Please note, for ad-hoc sessions we cannot claim funding, so you will receive an email confirmation, along with an invoice for payment. These sessions are then payable via the usual channels (either via Scopay or TFC) at our hourly rate of £7.50 and must be cleared before the session takes place.

#### **Paying via TFC**

As usual, please allow up to 5 working days for payment to clear and a further 5 days to clear with school.

If you wish to add Breakfast and After School Club to your child's standard sessions, please email the HEN team. Please note, we have limited spaces available this term.
