


## Hordle CE (VA) Primary School & Nursery

Autumn 1	Thankfulness Definition - Learning to be grateful for all that we have. Saying thank you to God for all our gifts. Thankfulness for each other, for our families our planet. Remembering to express our gratitude through our STEP manners. Link - STEP (thank you) Bible: Psalm 106:1 - Praise the Lord! Oh give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever!		*
Autumn 2	Gentleness Definition - Being gentle with each other, ourselves and the planet. Being gentle with our thoughts, actions and words. Living out God's purpose with compassion. Bible: Titus 3:2 - To speak evil of no one, to avoid quarreling, to be gentle, and to show perfect courtesy toward all people.	*	*
Spring 1	<b>Truth</b> Definition - Telling the truth - learning to be honest even when that is difficult for us. Learning that we can tell the truth to God through prayer and confession. Valuing truthfulness in others. <i>Bible: Ephesians 4:2 With all humility and gentleness, with</i> <i>patience, bearing with one another in love,</i>		*



Spring 2	Joy (Awe and wonder) Definition - The emotion of great delight or happiness caused by something exceptionally good or satisfying. Joy gives spiritual strength. Bible - Heb 12:2 "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him he endured he cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God".	
Summer 1	<b>Tolerance and Respect</b> Learning that we are all different and that there is much to be gained from this including our encounters with those of other faiths. That we can be different and yet always remain respectful. Learning what cannot and should not be tolerated. <i>Bible: Ephesians 4:2 - With all humility and gentleness, with</i> <i>patience, bearing with one another in love</i>	*
Summer 2	Hope Definition - Hope is one of our Core Values (ASPIRATION). Learning to live a life of hopefulness. That belief in God can make us hopeful. That hopelessness is an emotion that can make us feel desperate and sad. Bible: Isaiah - But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.	*

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Autumn 1	<b>Commitment</b> Definition - To show commitment through faith. Making a commitment to God e.g. through confirmation. Showing loyalty and strength in our commitment. Learning to show commitment to each other through loyalty, friendship and other relationships.		*
	Bible: 1 Kings 8:61 - And may your hearts be fully committed to the LORD our God, to live by his decrees and obey his commands, as at this time."		
Autumn 2	Love	*	*
	Definition - The primary key to everything. Along with temperance (self-control), love is a bookend that helps hold the other fruit in place. It is a love that surpasses human understanding and causes a person to be filled with the fullness of God		
	1 Corinthians 13:4-8. "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self- seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails"		
Spring 1	Self-control	*	*
	Self-control; To show control over our words, our thoughts, our minds, body and actions. A person who has self-control is mild and calm, avoids extreme behavior, and exercises self-restraint in both actions and speech.		
	Bible: 2 Timothy 1:7 - For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.		
Spring 2	Goodness	*	*
	Definition: God is the ultimate example of goodness. Goodness is faith put into practice and therefore goodness enables you to do good to those who you find it hard to love. We are called to be light in a dark world, through our goodness we can shine!

	Definition: Being humble and patient. Without pride or arrogance. Putting the needs of others first.		
	Bible: Psalms 37:11 plainly states that "the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace."

Putting ourselves into the shoes of others to try to understand their point of view.</li> <li>Following in the footsteps of Christ who cared for the most needy and who were outcast from society.</li> <li>Bible: Philippians 2:4</li> <li>Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.</li> </ul>

	Definition: Not holding a grudge. Showing mercy for those that might do us harm. Being able to move on. At Hordle we can always start again.

Spring 1	PatienceDefinition - To be patient with others. To not lose our temper. To be patient with the differences of others and their perceptions. To learn to be patient with ourselves.Bible: 1 Corinthians 13:4 - Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant	*	*
Spring 2	<b>Faithfulness</b> Being loyal and truthful - Doing what you say you are going to do. Being known as someone people can trust because you are reliable. Captain Responsibility! Following God's rules and laws for living a good life Bible: John 14:15 "If you love me, you will keep my commandments.	*	*
Summer 1	<b>Kindness</b> Definition: showing kindness to others in our thoughts, actions and words. Learning to be kind to others who are not our friends is the hardest lesson in kindness.	*	*
