Barnardos 'Healthy Hero' Visit -Wednesday 26th November

On Wednesday 26th November, we will be welcoming Barnado's in for a Healthy Hero Visit to talk about the importance of Oral Hygiene! This visit will include:

- Discussions around understanding how to look after our teeth.
- A short story about visiting the Dentist.
- Activities such as giant size teeth and tooth brushing, enabling the children to have a go at brushing the teeth with shaving foam and/or using laminated work-sheets to promote looking after their teeth.
- Discussing what foods can harm children's teeth and how to cut down on Sugar.

Children will be educated in a fun and interactive way, so that they understand the importance of looking after themselves and have the knowledge to implement healthy habits with the support of their parents, carers and Early Years providers.
