As part of our History learning about the Great Fire of London, the KS1 children have the exciting opportunity to visit Tudor House. This visit will help bring their learning to life and give the children a deeper understanding of the events of 1666 through real historical experiences and hands-on activities.

Who?	KS1
Where?	Tudor House, Southampton
When?	8 th July 2026
Why?	The visit will give the children the opportunity to deepen their understanding of the Great Fire of London through museum-led tours, workshops and hands-on activities.
Transport information	Please ensure that your children are in school by 8:40 am to give us enough time to ensure they are ready to get on the coach. Departing at 9.00 am and arriving back at school in time for usual pick up at 15:25pm.
Payment	£17.20 The cost of this trip is the cost to the school and no profit is made. (This payment is for coach hire, and museum entrance - including a workshop run by museum staff) We request that payment for this trip be made online via SCOPAY by Tuesday 23rd June 2026 (please find this trip under 'Trips and Events')
Clothing	Children are to wear <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trousers • Hordle PE top • Hordle Jumper or Hordle Hoodie • Trainers • Waterproof jacket and/or sun hat (weather dependent) to fit in their backpack. • Small backpack they can independently carry (to hold coat, lunch and water bottle) (Weather dependent, please apply a once-a-day suncream to your child prior to arriving at school)
Lunch arrangements	Please provide your child with a water bottle and a packed lunch which fits in their backpack. KS1 children are all entitled to a free school meal under a government scheme and this includes a packed lunch for school trips. Please complete THIS FORM by Thursday 23rd June 2026 to indicate which lunch you would like your child to have on the trip. This needs to be completed even if you will provide your own packed lunch.
Consent	The blanket trip consent covers this trip and therefore, you will need to let the school know IN WRITING that your child will not be attending by Tuesday 23rd June 2026 .
Medical Declaration	Please inform the office of any current illness or medical treatment relating to your child prior to the activity and provide the necessary medication. If your child has an inhaler in school, please ensure it is in school on the day and it is in date.

We are all looking forward to this trip and know that it will really help to enrich the children's learning opportunities about our current topic.
