As part of our Spring topic, the KS1 children will be taking part in an exciting visit from Crazy Creatures on Friday 27th February 2026. This hands-on workshop will give children the opportunity to meet and learn about a range of real animals up close.

The experience will support their learning in our science topic, Animals including Humans, helping them to deepen their understanding of different animal groups, their features and their habitats. It will also provide rich, first-hand knowledge to support their writing of animal fact files in English.

<b>Where?</b>	Crazy Creatures visit to Hordle Primary School
<b>When?</b>	Friday 27 <sup>th</sup> February 2026
<b>Why?</b>	Provide children with experience of real animals that link to both our science topic and our English writing
<b>Transport information</b>	This visit will be taking place in school and does not require any transport.
<b>Payment</b>	<p><b>£3.55</b></p> <p>The cost of this visit is the cost to the school and no profit is made. (This payment is to cover the cost of Crazy Creatures attending the school site and delivering their workshop.)</p> <p><b>We request that payment for this visit be made online via <a href="#">SCOPAY</a> by Friday 13th February (please find this visit under 'Trips and Events')</b></p>
<b>Clothing</b>	Children should wear their school uniform or PE kit as usual on this day.
<b>Lunch/Dinner arrangements</b>	Children will have their lunch in school as usual on this day.
<b>Consent</b>	The blanket trip consent covers this visit and therefore, you will need to let the school know <b>IN WRITING</b> that your child will not be attending by <b>Friday 13th February</b> .
<b>Medical Declaration</b>	<p>Please inform the office of any current illness or medical treatment relating to your child prior to the activity and provide the necessary medication.</p> <p><b>If your child has an inhaler in school, please ensure it is in school on the day and it is in date.</b></p>
