ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT

At Hordle CE (VA) Primary School, it is important that all visitors to our school feel supported during their visit and can access, where possible, all amenities and facilities.

Parking

Should you be a blue badge holder, please call the school prior to your visit and the school will reserve a parking space close to the entrance. A limited number of spaces are available at the front of the school with 1 allocated disabled bay. Additional parking is available on the surrounding roads and in the church car park located on the crossroads of Everton Road, Woodcock Lane and Hordle Lane.

Toilets

We do not currently have an adult accessibility toilet on site however, we do have one child’s accessible toilet which can be made available to visitors where required.

Hearing

We do not currently have a hearing loop in school however we are looking to purchase a portable hearing loop that can be used in smaller spaces (e.g. for meetings).

Access to buildings

We are primarily a single storey school building with level access to our main school hall and most classrooms. Should you require additional assistance, for example, to access a school production, please call the school in advance and we will make arrangements to support you.
