Dear Parents/Carers,

As a group of local schools, we are growing increasingly concerned about the impact of smartphones on our children.

Why are we concerned?

We fully appreciate that smartphones are a big part of life today. However, there is now a truly compelling amount of evidence and research into the negative effects of smartphones and social media on children and teenagers.

These include:

- Poor mental health, such as depression, anxiety and low self-esteem;
- Issues with cyberbullying, attention, focus and sleep;
- Exposure to dangerous and harmful content and inappropriate material;
- Smartphones are HIGHLY addictive so time spent on devices can significantly reduce the time spent playing, interacting and developing vital social skills;

Children often get their first phone in primary school and over 90% of 12-year-olds now have a smartphone. The same period in their young lives is crucial for brain development, and the younger a child gets a smartphone, the more harm it can therefore cause.

Who is making changes?

Schools are in a powerful position to change the norm, and support parents on this difficult issue. That's why Hampshire primary schools are now coming together to take collective action, and commit to making Hampshire primary schools genuinely smartphone free by January 2026.

We are committed to ensuring Hordle CE Primary School is smartphone free by January 2026, and are therefore emphasising that we do not want primary school children to bring a smartphone to school after this date.

We do understand the value of a phone for Y5/6 children who walk to and from school unaccompanied. However, we are confident that a smart phone is not necessary for this and a simple text / call type phone (brick phone), with no access to social platforms, offers this same level of security.

What does this mean for children at Hordle CE Primary School?

Many schools across Hampshire are insisting that smartphones are banned from 1st September 2025. However, we are mindful that families will need time to make suitable arrangements and we will therefore be introducing a ban on smartphones from 1st January 2026. The school office will continue to safely store any basic, non-internet enabled mobile phones throughout the day, for collection at the end of the day. But, from 1st January, please DO NOT send your child in with a smartphone.

We would urge you to take the time to watch the following clips which help explain the reasoning behind our decision to become Smartphone Free:

We would like to work together with parents/carers to safeguard children and preserve childhood. If all schools join together to implement this change, it is hoped that we can help parents/carers avoid the pressure to buy their child a smartphone too early. By doing so, we can not only protect our children's mental health and wellbeing, but we can also set a standard for how communities can come together to challenge the norms that no longer serve our children.
